

## 2018 Youth Olympic Games Selection Race

Canoeing Ireland will host a Youth Olympic Games (YOG) Canoe Slalom and Canoe Sprint selection race for young athletes aged 15 and 16 at Leixlip Lake on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

Athletes must compete in both Sprint and Slalom events of the same category, K1 or C1.

From this selection race a team of up 8 athletes, 2 K1 Men, 2 K1 Women, 2 C1 Men and 2 C1 Women can be selected to compete at the ICF World Qualification event in Barcelona, Spain from the 12th – 15th April 2018.
