Why do we need a new sea kayak award scheme?

I already have Canoeing Ireland Sea Kayak Skills awards, what happens to them?

Can I become a sea kayak instructor or Sea Kayak Club Leader with the new awards?

- The old system did not fulfil the needs of the modern Irish Sea Kayaker at L1 and L2.
- The Irish sea kayaking community has long called for an updated scheme relevant to them.
- The sea kayak community needs more Sea Kayak Club Leaders and Instructors.
- Designed to be specific to sea kayaking from L1 to L5, with clearly stated paddling conditions for weather, sea state and environment at each level.
- A modular approach at each level enabling you to progress at your pace.
- You decide which modules you work on and when.
- There is a steady progression in skill from L1- L5 to encourage greater engagement at L1 and L5.
- An innovative Specialisation Module at L5 allows paddlers to develop their own paddle related interests and 'give back' to the community.
- By continuous assessment at your pace. The awards use a Log Book and Paddle Journal system enabling you to progress along your paddling pathway in your own time when you are ready.
- A Canoeing Ireland instructor will observe you and sign off on parts of your log book as you progress. Once all modules of your chosen level of award are complete and signed off, you have the award, plain and simple. No more Exam Day!
- If you prefer to do a single once-off assessment you can easily arrange one with a qualified Canoeing Ireland Instructor.
- Your existing L3, L4, L5 certificates still stand. We invite you to explore the information sheets on the new awards to decide your progression pathway.
- Yes! Once you have completed the L3 sea skills award you are eligible to progress to the Sea Kayak Club Leader (in development) and Sea Kayak Instructor Awards. Check out the Canoeing Ireland Sea Kayak Awards Pathway on next page.
